Q: How frequently does the MAPP Committee convene and what types of stakeholders are involved?

A: The number of meetings with stakeholders using the MAPP process is not a static number. We have 2 cities and 12 unincorporated communities within Yuba County and would like to capture the needs unique to each community through these meetings and forums. Similarly, the types of stakeholders involved depend on the community and not necessarily strictly defined in the MAPP process, the purpose is to aim for diverse opinions represented in each community. This list can include but is not limited to employers, employees, local councils, non-profits, educational partners, parents, youth/youth advocacy, cultural groups, and philanthropists.

Q: What is the approximate budget for this work?

A: We are considering all reasonable budgets based on proposed scope of work and services provided.
