

**Yuba County South Annex Demolition
Invitation for Bid
Addendum #3
Dated 1/3/2012**

1. This addenda addresses the Hazardous Waste, Lead and Asbestos questions that have been raised on this project. The attached document is the Hazardous Material Survey Final Report dated 12/30/2011 provided by Entek Consulting Group, Inc.

Lead Based Paint was found to be present as well as paints containing lower levels of lead.

Construction debris waste profile testing indicates the waste which may be generated by the demolition of the building is not hazardous. The caveat to this is if the demolition contractor chooses to recycle materials instead of dispose of them he will be responsible for additional testing of waste streams since the samples we collected included the building as a whole.

A full abatement of the property has been completed, however, included in the attached document is an assumption that <5 sq. ft. of heat resistant mastic is present on header area of the Bryan Boiler Unit located in the Boiler Room.

The original asbestos study and all clearance documentation will be provided to the awarded bidder as stated in the Invitation for Bid documents.
